#### Matthew 1:18–21 (NLT)

<sup>18</sup> This is how Jesus the Messiah was born. His mother, Mary, was engaged to be married to Joseph. But before the marriage took place, while she was still a virgin, she became pregnant through the power of the Holy Spirit.

<sup>19</sup> Joseph, to whom she was engaged, was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her publicly, so he decided to break the engagement quietly. (NLT)

<sup>20</sup> As he considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. "Joseph, son of David," the angel said, "do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife. For the child within her was conceived by the Holy Spirit. (NLT)

<sup>21</sup> And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. (NLT)

#### **People in Nazareth...**

- thought Mary was IMMORAL
- It though t Joseph and Mary were Both IMMORAL
- saw Jesus as an ILLEGITIMATE child

Mark 6:3 (NIV) Isn't this the carpenter? Isn't this Mary's son and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas and Simon? Aren't his sisters here with us?" And they took offense at him.

Joseph was...

- ➤ a RIGHTEOUS man
- ➤ a COMPASSIONATE man
- > man of FAITH
- > an **OBEDIENT** man
- a COURAGEOUS man

#### **Joseph was Righteous and Compassionate**

- Cared MORE about Mary than himself
   Knew that FEELINGS were NOT a good
  - indication of Right or Wrong
- Believed the TRUTH about Mary

Galatians 2:20 (NIV) I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by FAITH in the Son of God, who Loved me and gave Himself for me.

2 Timothy 2:15 (NIV) Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who Correctly handles the word of truth.
