<sup>6</sup>...He came up to Jerusalem from Babylon, and the king gave him everything he asked for, because the gracious hand of the LORD his God was on him.



## Ezra Devoted Himself to...

STUDY - seek out the meaning
 OBEY - be Control by God's Word
 TEACH - help others understand

Colossians 3:16–17 (NIV) <sup>16</sup> Let the Word of Christ DWELL in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with ALL wisdom you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with Gratitude in your hearts to God.

### Artaxerxes Letter...

- Allowed the RETURN of More Exiles
- Provided GIFTS for the Temple
- Allowed Ezra to ask for SUPPLIES
- Forbid the TAXATION of Temple Employees
- Required Ezra to set up JUDICIAL System

By endorsing the Mosaic Law as the Social and Religious Authority throughout Judea, Artaxerxes conferred upon it the same civil power AS the Persian law. He pronounced the Law of your God and the law of the king as EQUAL. нотс
